

In light of the emergency that COVID-19 represents and in an effort to mitigate the spreading and effects of the virus, the Ministry of Communications and Transportation (the "SCT" for its acronym in Spanish), by means of a communication published in the Federal Official Gazette on June 30, 2020¹, determined to extend the period of days that shall not be considered business days for purposes of all acts and administrative proceedings being carried out before the different administrative units of the SCT, which is those running from March 19 and until **July 15, 2020**, without implying a suspension of work by the SCT.

During such days, the terms corresponding to the administrative procedures carried out before the administrative units of the SCT shall not be computed.
