
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ACTIVITIES AND ESTABLISHMENTS BY COVID-19 IS IMPOSED BY MEXICO CITY'S GOVERNMENT.

Mexico City's Major, through Bulletin 200/2020 dated March 22, 2020, ordered the temporary closure of the following activities and establishments:

- Museums
- Steam shower
- Gyms
- Churches and religious centers
- Cinemas
- Theaters
- Sports Centers
- Zoos
- Cultural Centers ("PILARES")
- Infant Development Centers ("CENDIS")
- Pubs
- Night clubs and discotheques
- Party rooms
- Public or private events of more than 50 people

The restriction is in effect from March 23 until April 16.

Additionally, the following four Committees were established to face the contingency: Water and Services, Budget, Health, and Economics. An economic program to support workers, vulnerable population and micro-businesses will be created. Finally, the local government will reduce 50% of municipal workers who do not have substantive duties (without affecting their income).

Finally, today the Federal Government declared that the country is in Phase 2 of the epidemic; however, it was not explained the consequences or specific actions that this implies.
